KEY PROJECTS

BENDIGO HERITAGE ATTRACTIONS - CENTRAL DEBORAH GOLD MINE MASTER PLAN AND BUSINESS CASE

Urban Enterprise provided an assessment of the key attractions of BHA, including the Central Deborah Gold Mine, the Bendigo Tramways and the Bendigo Joss House Temple. Key projects were identified to assist in the revitalisation of the tourism attractions and increase the financial viability of the organisation. The revitalisation of the Central Deborah Gold Mine was identified as the number one priority project and progressed to concept planning and business case development.

Urban Enterprise identified a number of opportunities for the revitalisation of the above ground experience at the Central Deborah Gold Mine. Working collaboratively with Cumulus Design Studio, a number of concept options were prepared that responded to the identified market opportunities, as well as the physical constraints of the site.

The project outputs included an Issues and Opportunities Paper for the three key attractions, a Master Plan and Business Case Document (including Master Plan and three concept renders) and a short promotional video of the concept.

The project has subsequently been identified as a major project in *Plan Greater Bendigo* and is being advocated for Government funding. The project was completed on behalf of the City of Greater Bendigo, Regional Development Victoria and Bendigo Heritage Attractions (BHA).

YARRAWONGA LIBRARY NEEDS ANALYSIS AND SITE IDENTIFICATION

Urban Enterprise was engaged by Moira Shire Council to assess the demand for a new Library in Yarrawonga and potential sites for redevelopment. Urban Enterprise identified that the current library was not meeting the needs of the local community in providing contemporary library services and was lacking in floorspace to service the needs of the community. Urban Enterprise assessed a range of sites and locations and identified the Town Hall site as the preferred option for redevelopment. The strategic opportunity to create a civic and cultural hub in the town centre was identified, with the potential for the site to host a library, arts and cultural activities. The report was unanimously adopted by Council and Urban Enterprise have subsequently been engaged by to prepare a Master Plan and Business Case for the site, which is currently underway.

PORT FAIRY STRUCTURE PLAN ECONOMIC AND TOURISM ANALYSIS

Urban Enterprise was engaged by Moyne Shire Council to prepare an Economic and Tourism Analysis of Port Fairy to inform the preparation of the Port Fairy Structure Plan. Urban Enterprise provided demographic and population forecasts, an examination of housing characteristics and trends, demand and supply analysis of residential, commercial, industrial and tourism land uses, identified issues and opportunities relevant to residential, commercial and employment land provision in Port Fairy and provided recommendations relating to the role and scale of land for employment, commercial, retail, industrial and tourism uses.
